Christ the King Mercy Preschool Admissions and Registration Policy

These are the basic Preschool Requirements (please see the Preschool Handbook for complete details:

- Children should be potty-trained:
 - o Capable of fastening and unfastening pants
 - o Using restroom without assistance
 - o Washing hands
- Child must turn 3 on or before August 1st for the 3-year-old program
- Child must turn 4 on or before August 1st for the 4-year-old program
- Completed Registration Process

To keep the class experience as productive as possible, there will be a limit of 20 children per day in the Preschool classroom. In order to receive your first choices, it is imperative that you fill out the Preschool Registration form and return it on or before Preschool Registration Night. After Registration Night, the remaining spaces will be filled on a first-come first-served basis.

In the event that a specific day is above limit at Registration, preference will be given in this order:

- 1. Returning Preschoolers (attended Christ the King Mercy last year)
- 2. Preschoolers with siblings registered in Christ the King School (K-8)
- 3. Children of Parishioners of Christ the King or St. Rita
- 4. Children of Parishioners of other Parishes
- 5. Children without a Parish affiliation or non-Catholic children.

<u>Fully Completed</u> Registration packets will be numbered as they are received. After preference criteria are met, we will use these numbers as a first-come-first-served method.
